Privacy Policy

Effective: May 1, 2019

This policy statement tells you how the Pete's Mountain Water Company (PMWC) collects, uses, and discloses electronic personal information as a result of your being a member and/or your emailing us or your use of our website.

The information provided in this Privacy Policy is not intended to create a contract of any kind, express or implied, and should not be treated as such. This Privacy Policy applies only to this website. If you link to another site, you are no longer on our website and this Privacy Policy will not apply. This Privacy Policy is subject to change without notice.

"Personal information" is information about a natural person that identifies or describes an individual and is readily identifiable to that individual, including, but not limited to, his or her name, home address, and telephone number(s).

"Electronically-collected personal information" includes your domain name or Internet Protocol address, and statistical information about which web pages you visit on our site. We do not collect or store electronically-collected personal information.

If you are a Member of the Company, we collect specific information that you supply us for the purposes of administering the water company and billing you for your water usage. This information includes your name, address, phone number(s), email address(es), and details about and testing status of your back-flow prevention device(s).

We will take reasonable steps to ensure that the personal information we collect is accurate, complete, and up-to-date. You will notify us if any information we have for you is inaccurate or has been updated.

We will add your contact information to our database to use in contacting you about water company topics. The information is shared with our bookkeeping firm

and our water service manager. Except for authorized law enforcement investigations or when otherwise compelled by law or judicial order, we do not share your personal information or email with any other organizations outside of those necessary to administer the company.

We will preserve the content of any email you send us if we believe that we have a legal or business requirement to do so.

No data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be totally secure or reliable, and we cannot warrant the security, integrity, or privacy of personal information submitted via our website or email. But we will take all prudent measures to safeguard it once it reaches us, including but not limited to protecting it with physical and computer security, anti-virus protection, limiting distribution among the Board and its service partners, and auditing. This information should not be construed in any way as giving business, legal, or other advice, or warranting as fail proof the security of information provided to us.
